CARRIAGE OF PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED PASSENGERS

- (A) Except as provided in Rules 20 (Carriage of Physically Handicapped Passengers), 25 (Refusal To Transport - Limitations of Carrier) and 500 (Passengers on Stretchers) carrier will refuse to transport any passenger whose physical condition is such that he may need the assistance of another person to move expeditiously to an exit in the event of an emergency, unless the passenger is accompanied by another person who is capable of assisting such passenger in expeditiously moving to an exit. At least one such other person is required for every two such handicapped passengers.

NOTE: In case of any doubt as to the passenger's capability of expeditiously moving to an exit without assistance, the passenger will be required to demonstrate privately the capability of moving from one chair to another. If he can do so, he will be deemed to be capable of expeditiously moving to an exit without assistance.

- (B) Although carrier will provide special board and deplaning assistance to a physically handicapped person, carrier is not obligated to provide in-flight assistance (e.g., to a lavatory) to such a passenger other than that provided to passengers not so handicapped.
