RULE

SECTION I - GENERAL RULES

C26

+[N]NAVIGATION SURCHARGE (Applicable for transportation to/from Canada)

- (A) A navigation surcharge of CAD 15.00 will be collected at the time of ticket issuance for travel between Canada and Mexico/South America and for transpacific travel to/from Canada including through passengers with a stopover in Canada exceeding 24 hours. The surcharge of CAD 15.00 applies to all passengers and will apply in each direction.
- (B) Fare calculation show as Q surcharge, by converting the CAD surcharge amount into NUC using the applicable IATA rate of exchange (IROE).
- (C) The surcharge applies in addition to all other charges and is not subject to any further discounts.
- (D) The navigation surcharge will not apply for travel to/from Japan via the Atlantic/Pacific.
- (E) The navigation surcharge will accrue to Air Pacific when travel to/from Canada is via the services of Air Pacific.
- (F) The navigation surcharge will not apply to the following:
 (1) Tour Conductors discounted tickets.
 (2) Joint round the world type fares.

- Effective July 4, 2001 for transportation to/from USA.
 - Effective August 18, 2001 for transportation to/from Canada.
